Cheap ways to clean your home all year round.
Friendly non-toxic products

All-purpose Spray/Cleaner

Best used for all surfaces, walls, floors, cupboards, window seals

- 2 t a b l e s p o o n of eucalyptus oil
- 2 tablespoon washing soda
- 2 tablespoon of dish washing liquid
- 1 1/2 cup of hot water
- 2 tablespoon of white vinegar
- 4 cups of cold water
- 1 litre bottle or spray bottle



Mix washing soda, dish washing liquid and eucalyptus oil with cup of hot water in bowl.

In the 1 litre bottle add 2 cups of cold water and vinegar, add in the mix from the bowl into the bottle.

Shake well before use

Room Spray

Best used in the rooms for fresh smells

- 10-20 drops of lemon oil
- 10-20 drops of purify oil
- 1 teaspoon of witch hazel
- 200ml of water
- 500ml spray bottle

Mix lemon, purify, witch hazel and water in spray bottle. Shake up and use

Window & Glass Spray

Best used on windows, glass, and mirrors

- 15 drop of lemon oil
- 250ml of white vinegar
- 250ml of water
- 500ml spray bottle

Mix lemon, vinegar, and water in spray bottle. Shake well before use

Mould Spray

Best used on walls, cupboards, and ceiling

- 30 drops of clove oil
- 1 teaspoon witch hazel
- 500ml of water
- 500ml spray bottle

Mix clove, witch hazel and water into spray bottle. Shake well before use

Bathroom Spray

Best used in the bathtub, sink, taps

- 10-20 drops of tea tree oil
- 10-20 drops of lemon oil or juice
- 250ml of white vinegar
- 250ml of water
- 500ml Spray bottle



Mix tea tree oil, lemon oil or juice, vinegar, and water in spray bottle. Shake well before use

Toilet Spray

Best used in toilet area and bowl

- 10 drops of lemon oil
- 10 drops of peppermint oil
- 100ml of white vinegar
- 30ml of dish washing liquid
- 500ml spray bottle

Mix lemon, peppermint, vinegar, and dish washing liquid in spray bottle. Shake well before use

Bathroom & Toilet Scrub

Best used in the bathtub, sink, taps

- 500g of bi-carb soda
- 3 tablespoon of dish washing liquid
- 200ml white vinegar in a spray bottle

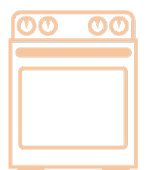


Mix bi-carb soda, dish washing liquid into a paste and start wiping down, leave for 2 mins before spraying on vinegar to make the paste bubble before wiping away

Oven Cleaner

Best use on kitchen oven, stove, and oven racks

- 8 drops of lemon oil
- 500g baking soda
- 1 cup of water



Mix baking soda and water together to make paste add lemon into the paste, use cloth to wipe on oven, leave for 1 hour before wiping off
