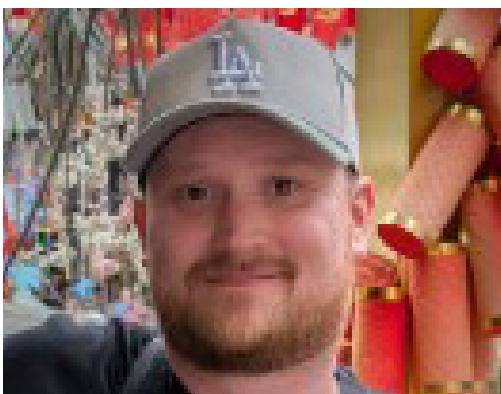
Uncle Alan Brown
