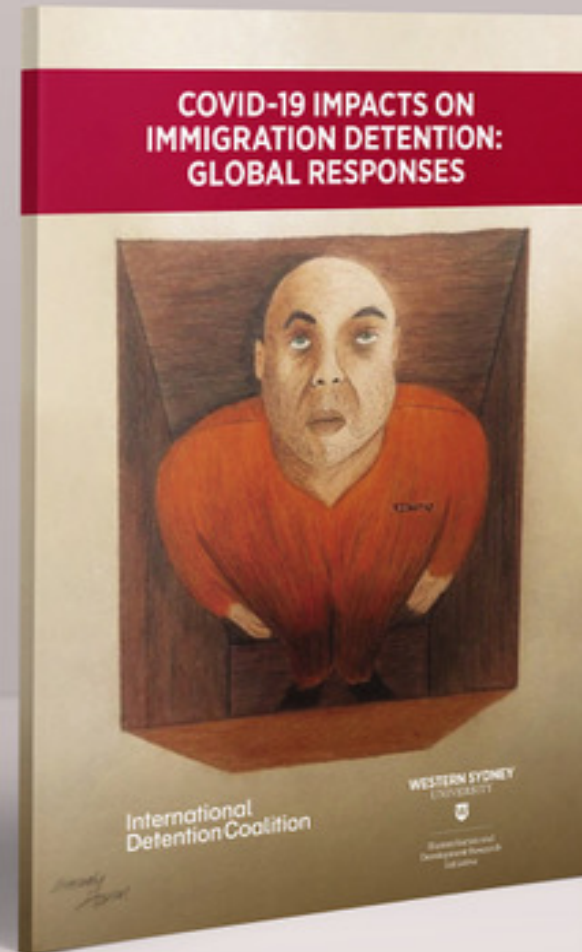

OPPORTUNITIES

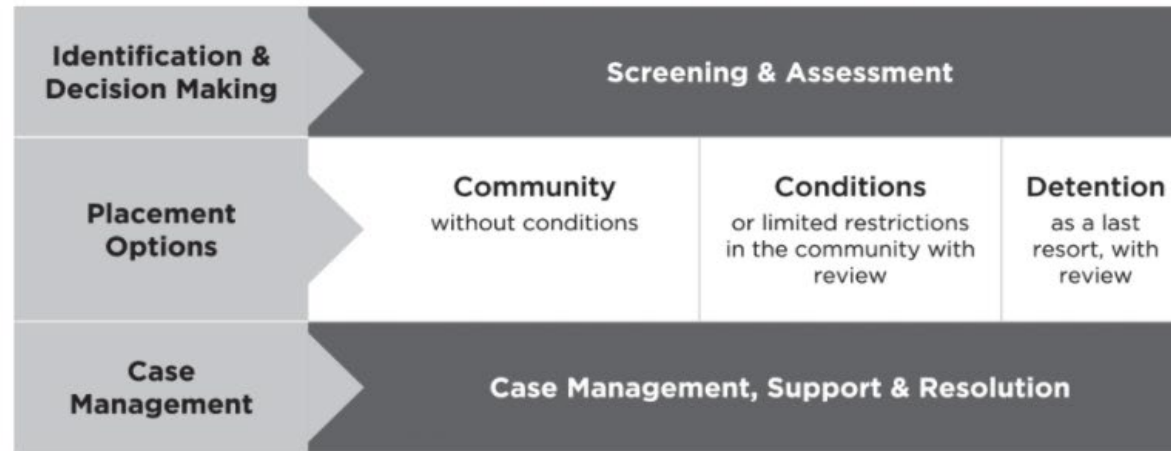
- Engagement around public health
